<i>Parent Comprehensive Case History</i>	Conducted jointly as requested by parents	Initial discussion with one therapist of family / child needs to determine point of entry for service assessment and development. Outlining of service types available.	\$200
<i>Initial psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist assessment.</i>	Conducted by individual therapist as determined by child's needs.	Initial assessment to determine developmental level and facilitate service planning and prioritising of interventions.	\$200
<i>Multi Disciplinary Initial assessment (Pre Intervention).</i>	Conducted jointly by psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	Initial assessment to determine developmental level and facilitate service planning and prioritising of interventions.	\$200
<i>Individual therapy programs</i>	Conducted individually by psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	Individual therapy interventions that may occur in therapist rooms, at home, kindy / school and childcare / playgroup situations. Interventions may be provided directly to child or through parent skill development during these sessions.  Provision of a summary report and ongoing programming suggestions to facilitate ongoing development.	\$200

<b><i>Multidisciplinary therapy programs</i></b>	Conducted jointly by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	Individual therapy interventions that may occur in therapist rooms, at home, kindy / school and childcare / playgroup situations. Interventions may be provided directly to child or through parent skill development during these sessions. Provision of a summary report and ongoing programming suggestions to facilitate ongoing development.	\$200
<b><i>Group Therapy Program</i></b>	Conducted jointly by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	The small group program for up to 6 children to address specific skill development for children and parent.	Set per child
<b><i>Family education sessions</i></b>	Conducted jointly by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	Provision of information and development of skills and techniques for the promotion of child development and ongoing management.	\$200
<b><i>Individual parent sessions</i></b>	Conducted by a psychologist.	Individual therapy to support families understanding their child's diagnosis and management.	\$200
<b><i>Specific issue consultation</i></b>	Conducted individually by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist.	Individual communication with families providing support in understanding their child's diagnosis, development and ongoing management strategies.	\$200

<b><i>Individual Positive Behavioural Support Programs</i></b>	Psychologist / therapy aid / teacher		\$200
<b><i>Pre educational comprehensive assessment and report</i></b>	Conducted individually by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist as determined by client need.	Conduct full assessment for each discipline and provide comprehensive report to assist determining educational support needs.	\$200
<b><i>Kindergarten and School transition visits</i></b>	Conducted individually by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist as determined by client need.	Support individual clients as they transition to school or kindergarten by attending transition visits, school meetings and or training of teachers and support staff.	\$200
<b><i>Professional support at meetings</i></b>	Provided by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist as determined by client need.	Provide professional information and support to individual clients at predetermined case meetings as requested by family.	\$200
<b><i>Regional visits</i></b>	Provided by a combination of psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist as determined by client need.	Provision of individual assessment and treatment as need determines. Negotiated access with rural and remote families, supplemented through the use of technological communications.	Quotation negotiated.
